THE REHEARSAL:

Please arrive to the venue by 4:15 PM. The parking garage requires you to download an app in order to pay for parking and the process can take a few minutes. Take this time before the rehearsal start to get that taken care of so that you are prepared for the wedding day.

The ceremony rehearsal will begin by 4:30 PM sharp and conclude at 5:30 PM. We will practice walking down the aisle, walking back up the aisle and discussing how you will stand during the actual wedding ceremony.

The rehearsal dinner will begin at 6:00 PM at Martinos in downtown Ashland.

Saturday is a very early morning so please head to bed early, keep drinking to a minimum and have everything you will need on the wedding day ready to go.

HOW THE MORNING GOES:

You will hang out with the bridesmaids the morning of. Be sure to eat breakfast before you sit in the chair for hair and makeup services – It will be a long day until dinner is finally served. If you choose to drink champagne or any other alcoholic beverages, be sure to drink equal amounts of water to stay hydrated. We want to make sure you enjoy every minute of the celebration!

Hair will begin at the salon at 8:00 AM. You will get your hair curled and pinned last around 10:30 AM. The salon address is: 30 Hawthorne Street, Medford

Be sure to have a clean face and clean dry hair prior to hair and makeup services. You will want to wear a shirt that can easily go over your head without messing up your hair and makeup. I recommend a button down shirt or a robe. Your makeup services will begin starting at: 12:45 PM.

Hair & Makeup Artist Requests:

- Please wear tops that are easily removed without disturbing hair or makeup
- Please arrive with clean, dry hair and clean faces (no makeup and no skincare products)
- Please avoid being on your phone during your services as it can slow down the process
- Please have inspiration photos in hand when arriving for services
- Please make sure hair extensions are already in your hair prior to services

- If your hair is thick or curly and you desire a smooth updo or soft curl style, you must smooth your hair prior to services

Be sure to tidy your belongings as you go to keep the room clean for the photographer and to make it a smooth transition at the end of the night. Be sure to have your overnight bag ready to go as well.

You will then slip into your gown at 3:30 PM. Once the dress is on, it is show time and the photos begin! Your formal portraits with your maids will follow a few minutes later at 4:00 PM.

Be sure to take in each moment because once the photos start, it can become a blur. After portraits are completed, take a breath, use the ladies' room and prepare to head to the ceremony space. At 4:50 PM, the lady in waiting will escort you and your father to the ceremony. Once the ceremony begins, watch the day unfold in a magical way!

After the ceremony concludes, you will be involved in pictures with family, the full bridal party and with your bride! Becca or her assistant will come bring you appetizers and drinks. Once the portraits conclude, you will make your grand entrance into the ballroom. The father of the bride will say a prayer over dinner and then food will be served. This is a great time to mingle with your guests while food is served, but be sure to eat a few bites of food yourself!

FAIRY DUST TIPS:
